INSTRUCTIONS TO THE CANDIDATES

1. Enter all the details on the test booklet as on the OMR sheet in places earmarked and verify. Any wrong entry may entail rejection of your paper.
2. The paper consists of 100 multiple choice questions with 4 answers. Before starting to answer the questions, verify whether you have got the correct test booklet and the Test Booklet contains 100 questions with answers. In case of any discrepancy, immediately bring it to the notice of the Room Supervisor within the first 5 minutes for issuing of an alternate test booklet. After 5 minutes, neither the test booklets will be replaced nor will extra time be given.
3. Each question has four alternative answers A, B, C, D. The correct answer has to be chosen and you have to darken the respective circle on the OMR sheet against the respective question as follows:
Example: (A) (B) (C) (D) where B is the correct answer.
4. The candidate shall use only Blue/Black ball point pen.
5. A candidate shall darken only one circle and forbidden from darkening more than one circle. If a candidate darkens more than one circle, such answers will be considered as un-attempted questions, and the candidate will have no claim over the answer.
6. The candidate shall darken the circle carefully, if once chosen an answer and darkened the circle, there is no scope for correction of the answer. Use of whiteners, erasers etc are forbidden.
7. The candidate is forbidden from disclosing his identify either by writing his name or any other symbol or mark on any part of the OMR sheet except in the space provided for the relevant entries.
8. The candidate shall return the OMR sheet to the respective Room Supervisor at the end of the Test. Before handing over the OMR, please verify whether you have written correct register number on the OMR sheet, you have affixed your signature at the place provided and the Room Supervisor has put his signature and date on the OMR sheet. Otherwise, there is chance for rejection of your answer sheet.
9. The candidate is forbidden from taking the Test Booklet and the OMR sheet outside the examination hall during the Examination. However, after handing over the OMR sheet at the end of the examination duration, the candidate take along with him the used test booklet and the carbon copy of the OMR sheet.
10. If a candidate wishes to leave the examination during the middle of the examination, he will not be allowed to take away the Test booklet along with him. However, a candidate is not allowed to leave the examination hall during the last 20 minutes of the Examination.
11. There is no negative marking for the incorrect answer.
12. The candidate shall abide by all the rules and regulations of the University regarding the conduct of examination and should not indulge in activities coming under the purview of Malpractice.
13. A candidate is forbidden from carrying a Mobile phone, I-phone, calculator or any other electronic device into the examination hall. In case accidentally a candidate has brought any of such things, he shall hand it over to the Room Supervisor before the commencement of the examination and collect it back after the completion of the examination. **In case candidate is found to possess any of such devices, he will be booked under the Malpractice Case.**
